# NYC & Philadelphia Trip Handbook



#### **General Rules**

- Our trip is a school function of Dublin Scioto High School. All school rules as
  listed in the student handbook and Extra-Curricular Code will be enforced
  24 hours a day. Failure to follow these rules and any other rules deemed
  necessary by Mr. Doherty will result in disciplinary action. In severe cases, the
  student may be sent home at the parent's expense on the first available flight.
- Possession of any controlled substance (drugs, alcohol, etc.) or weapon of any kind is strictly prohibited. Parents and school administration will be notified immediately and the student will be sent home on the first available flight at the parent's expense. School disciplinary action will be levied upon return to school and authorities will be notified if necessary.
- Students must follow the itinerary for the entire trip. Students must stay with their assigned group. **No one is to go off alone at any time, no exceptions.**
- New York and Philadelphia are big cities! Keep your valuables in a front pocket. You are responsible for the safekeeping of your personal belongings.
- Students are to wear their lanyards at all times. Chaperone phone numbers are on the back of your nametags.
- Students are expected to conduct themselves with courtesy, respect, and professionalism at all times.

#### **Bus Rules**

- Students must ride the same bus for the entire trip. Attendance will be taken at each stop. Students must be on time when returning to the bus.
- The directors or chaperones are in charge while on the bus. Insubordination to a chaperone will result in assigned seats.
- The bus is to be kept clean. Everyone is to police their own area. Garbage bags will be provided. The bus is to be checked and trash picked up at each stop.
- We will not use the bus restroom on the trip, please plan accordingly at rest stops.
- The bus is equipped with a DVD player. Students may bring G, PG, or PG-13 movies to watch. Movies will be selected at the discretion of the directors.

## **Hotel Rules**

- Curfews will be strictly enforced. Bed checks will be made by chaperones
  every night and students must remain in their rooms between bed check and
  the first breakfast report time. If assistance is needed at night, students are to
  call their chaperone. We have a private security guard for our section of the
  hotel each night.
- No expenses may be charged to the hotel room.

- Hotel rooms are to be kept clean and free from damages. Chaperones will check rooms daily. Students will be financially responsible for any damage.
- No loud or disruptive behavior is permitted. Please be respectful of your peers, chaperones, directors, and other guests of the hotel.

### **Trip Communication**

- Remind
  - We will use the Remind App to communicate during this trip.
  - Remind is a one-way communication system. Do not attempt to reach the directors with a private message on the app.
  - Everyone attending the trip must sign up with Remind, no exceptions.
     This will be the primary form of communication throughout the trip.

- Groupme
  - The directors and chaperones will use GroupMe to communicate during this trip.
- Chaperones will use a group text to communicate directly with their group. Chaperones will always be the first contact for any issues.
- Keep a copy of the schedule handy (like your phone background or a copy on your lanyard) at all times.
- Be sure to get off the bus with your group, and head immediately to your destination. We are unable to stand around once you exit the bus.
- In the event of an emergency, chaperones will have your students emergency contacts and medical information. Directors will be notified immediately and we will take all necessary action to ensure that your child is safe.
- Should anything happen, the directors will reach out to family members as soon as possible

## **Advice**

- Keep in mind that no one on the trip needs to know how much money you are bringing or where you are keeping it when it is not on your person. It is a good idea to have a secure place in your luggage to keep some of your money where you can get it, but it would not be easy for someone else to find without looking carefully. Hiding money in your packed clothes is best.
- Remember that very few of you will look like you are not a tourist. It will be easy for pickpockets to notice you as an easy target. Carry your money and phone in an inside pocket or zipped pocket of your jacket if possible. You do not need to be afraid just be sensible. There is also a zipped pocket in your lanyard and your lanyard can be worn inside your shirt or jacket.

## **Packing Checklist**

**Schedule Note:** You will want to wear comfortable clothes for the overnight bus trip to NYC. You will need to pack a change of clothes in your carry on bag. You will not be able to get to your suitcase until we check into the hotel late Monday night.

Remember, we must fit all of your luggage, instruments, and uniforms under the bus. Be mindful of the size of your luggage. The carry on bag should be a smaller backpack, and your suitcase should be medium sized at most.
