FORMS, FEES, & DATES

REGISTRATION

- Your band camp registration reserves your spot in the marching band show.
 Please register no later than 5/14 so that we can provide accurate information to our drill writer.

FORMS

- Band camp forms will be collected no *earlier* than our first summer rehearsal on 7/1...
- We will collect **paper copies** of all forms. We encourage you to keep a digital version of your forms just in case.
- Students who have not correctly completed and submitted all forms will not be allowed to attend band camp.
- Please note that some forms must be notarized
 - We will have a notary available at select rehearsals to help this process.
 Dates will be released as we approach the summer rehearsals.

- Camp Bountiful is about 18 miles south of Chillicothe off Route 35. The trip takes about an hour and a half.
- Timeline
 - Saturday Staff, Select Chaperones, seniors, amd section leaders report to Camp Bountiful
 - Sunday Full ensemble reports, check-in. Rehearsal begins at 3pm
 - Monday-Friday Rehearsals
 - Saturday Preview performance, clean-up. We must be out no later than noon! • Travel
- Camp Check In
 - o Arrive at Camp Bountiful between 1:00p and 2:30p for check-in.
 - o Be sure that your forms are correctly submitted before arriving at camp.
 - At check-in, you will be assigned your cabin number and we will verify any allergies, food restrictions, or accommodations that you require.
 You will also leave your medicine with our nurse.
 - Seniors & section leaders will check in on Saturday to help setup camp.
 An itinerary will be released closer to band camp.
 - No students are permitted to drive to camp alone.

CAMP GUIDELINES & PROCEDURES

Supervision

- The camp managers and Mr. Doherty will handle the overall planning and supervision. We will have multiple types of personnel to assist.
 - Teaching Staff: Mr. Doherty. Ms. Auhbil, Mr. Vogt, and any other staff members
 - Chaperones: Band parents supervise the students in the cabins at night and during free time
 - Medical/Nurse: We are currently searching for a nurse for this week. If you are interested in volunteering, contact Mr. Doherty ASAP.
 - o **Lifeguard**: Provided by the camp
- Chaperones
 - We need chaperones for band camp! We will have a few meetings over the summer to help recruit and train the chaperone team
 - This is an incredible experience to see your child in a different light.
 You will have an inside look at their hard work, dedication, and will

get to see them interact with their friends and have fun!

- Chaperones will be responsible for the following items
 - Assisting check-in
 - Assisting camp setup
 - Supervising during free time and cabin time
 - Assisting setup special events during camp
 - Having fun with our wonderful students!

STUDENT RESPONSIBILITY

- This is a school sponsored event; therefore, all students must adhere to the student code of conduct.
- All students are expected to treat every student, staff member, camp staff, and chaperone with respect **at all times**.
- Self-discipline is expected of each student. Per the Dublin City School agreement, students who do not adhere to the district code of conduct will be sent home from camp at the discretion of the directors.
- Students are given an amount of free time each day to use the pool, playground, basketball court, and other facilities at Camp Bountiful. Students will be under adult supervision at all times and again, are expected to adhere to proper behavior expectations always.
- Any activities that could be considered hazing will not be tolerated. Any student who takes part in these activities will be immediately removed from camp and expelled from the ensemble.
