Band Camp Student Responsibilities

Student Responsibility Agreement

- This is a school sponsored event; therefore, **all students must adhere to the student code of conduct.**
- All students are expected to treat every student, staff member, camp staff, and chaperone with respect **at all times.**
- Self-discipline is expected of each student. Per the Dublin City School agreement, students who do not adhere to the district code of conduct will be sent home from camp at the discretion of the directors.
- Any activities that could be considered hazing **will not be tolerated.** Any student who takes part in these activities **will be immediately removed from camp and expelled from the ensemble.**

General Band Camp Rules

- We are guests at Camp Bountiful. Students will respect the grounds, belongings, and rules that Camp Bountiful has posted.
 - Chaperones will hold daily cabin inspections
 - Students will clean up after themselves at meals
 - Students will be dismissed from camp after they have cleaned their area
- The Dublin Scioto dress code applies to all clothes packed for camp
- Be prompt to all scheduled activities
 - Students are to be in their cabins by 10:30pm
 - Lights out is at 11:00pm
 - Wake-up call is 7:00am, warm-ups are at 7:30am
 - Students are not to leave their cabin between 10:30pm and 6:30am unless accompanied by a chaperone
- Students are not to visit each others cabins
- Students are responsible for the care and safety of their own items
- Visitors are not permitted without prior approval from the directors
- Cooking appliances are not permitted
- You must wear footwear at all times (no bare feet)
 - **You will need two pairs of shoes and PLENTY of extra socks**

Students who are unable to follow these guidelines **will be sent home from camp** with a scheduled meeting upon return to determine the students future in the Scioto band program.
